Directions to Public Works Maintenance Facility – 900 London Bridge Road

Option 1:

Take Highway 95 to Kiowa intersection (Circle K and Cowboys RV). Turn on Kiowa to travel about ½ mile toward the lake. Make a right turn on Aviation Drive (where Kiowa begins to curve). At the top of the knoll (almost immediately), turn left and travel down road into maintenance facility grounds. Turn right at the far end of the building, then another immediate right into parking area that fronts school bus parking.

Option 2:

Take Highway 95 to Mesquite/London Bridge Road intersection (In&Out Burger and English Village parking lot). Turn on London Bridge Road to travel lake side of the highway. Follow London Bridge Road about 3 miles, past Industrial Boulevard. Just past Dover Drive, you will see the Campbell Redi-Mix towers on the right. The maintenance facility is next door. Turn right on Doyle Drive into the facility grounds and straight into parking area that fronts school bus parking.

Enter the building through the double glass doors on the lake side.
